Purpose

The SERC Critical Infrastructure Protection Committee (CIPC) Physical Security Subcommittee (CIPC - PSS) shall review the NERC Reliability Standards related to physical security and provide technical guidance regarding the Standards and their implementation. In addition, the CIPC - PSS shall develop, review, and provide regional input on various industry physical security initiatives, working groups, and task forces, as appropriate.

Responsibilities and Activities

The following is a list of the CIPC - PSS responsibilities and routine activities:

Responsibilities

- 1. Serve as the expert advisory group regarding physical security to all SERC Committees, Subcommittees, Working Groups and Task Forces.
- 2. Represent and coordinate SERC regional physical security concerns and positions with the SERC Critical Infrastructure Protection Committee (CIPC) and SERC representatives to the NERC CIPC.
- 3. Provide security awareness of emerging physical security technologies for the industry.
- 4. Promote information sharing on physical security incidents, threats and vulnerabilities.

Activities

- 1. Review NERC Reliability Standards CIP-004, CIP-006 and CIP-014 to provide regional input for implementing the physical security requirements. Make recommendations to the CIPC, as appropriate.
- 2. Monitor, review, and report on industry physical security initiatives, and report back to the CIPC.
- 3. Conduct forums, workshops and/or give presentations on physical security issues as appropriate to the SERC Committees.
- 4. Provide opportunities for members to network, interact and share physical security knowledge and experience.

Representation

Each SERC member company that has a representative appointed to the SERC CIPC is entitled to appoint one representative and one alternate to the CIPC - PSS. Each CIPC - PSS representative and alternate should demonstrate physical security expertise in the electric industry.

CIPC - PSS representatives shall serve for a term of two years, but can be re-appointed. Terms should be staggered, when possible, to permit the presence of experienced CIPC - PSS representatives and alternates. The SERC CIPC chair shall appoint a CIPC - PSS representative to serve as the CIPC - PSS chair and a CIPC - PSS representative to serve as vice chair. The CIPC - PSS chair and vice chair should be selected from different SERC member companies, when possible, to provide diversity. The chair and vice chair shall serve for a term of two years that commences on November 1 of the appointment year and ends on October 31 of the second year. The vice chair will normally succeed the chair.

Governance

CIPC - PSS decisions and recommendations are generally made by consensus. If a vote is required, each representative (or alternate if the representative is not available) shall have one vote. A majority of the CIPC - PSS representatives present at a scheduled meeting or conference call is needed to approve any motion or vote.

Reporting

The CIPC - PSS reports to the SERC CIPC. The CIPC - PSS shall report to or work with other SERC or industry groups as directed by the SERC CIPC.
